WHEREAS, the Galveston County Consolidated Drainage District (the “District”) is a political subdivision of the State of Texas in accordance with Chapter 49 and Chapter 56 of the Texas Water Code;

WHEREAS, The District Drainage Criteria Manual publishes the District’s rules and regulations as it relates to the construction of improvements within the District jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, the District desires to amend the Criteria Manual to clarify and strengthen the District’s processes for enforcement of District regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GALVESTON COUNTY CONSOLIDATED DRAINAGE DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct.

Section 2: The District hereby amends Section IV. Entitled “Enforcement” to add a subsection M which shall read as follows:

M. Any civil penalties assessed by the District must be disposed before the District reviews or submits before the Board of Directors for approval any Final Drainage Plans.

Section 3: The Board hereby enacts a requirement for further changes to Section IV of the Criteria Manual to require a supermajority decision, meaning four out of five Board members must vote in the affirmative.


Section 4. The Board of Directors authorizes the District staff to take an action necessary to implement the terms of this resolution and order.

Section 5. Any resolution or policy of the District inconsistent with this Resolution is repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
